Steps to upgrade a Freedom Client

1. Backup current configuration
2. Exit Freedom Client application
3. Un-install current version of Freedom
4. Install new version of Freedom
5. Import saved configuration into new version

Backing up an existing configuration

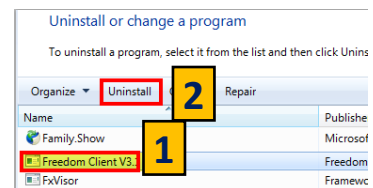
To perform a backup of the current Freedom software configuration follow these steps.

1. Click on the UP arrow icon  then select "**Backup system parameters**"
2. In the 'Save As' dialog window that opens choose the location you wish the file to be saved to.
3. Type a name for your backup (i.e. **Freedom_backup_Nov2013**).

Un-installing the current version of Freedom Client

For Windows 7 or Vista navigate to '**Control Panal**' and click on either '**Uninstall a program**' or '**Program and Features**' from the list.




1. Find '**Freedom V3.x**' in the list, click on it.
2. Click '**Uninstall**' For Windows XP choose '**Add Remove**' programs from the Control Panel.



Install new version

Install the new version of the Freedom Software as normal.

Importing the config into new version

1. Open Freedom software if it isn't already open.
2. In LiveView click the '**Arrow**' icon 
3. Click '**Import system parameters**' option from list.
4. Browse to the location of the backup file.  (Backup files have a '**.config**' extension.)
5. Click on the actual file then click '**Open**'. 
6. You must **restart** the Freedom software application for settings to take effect.
