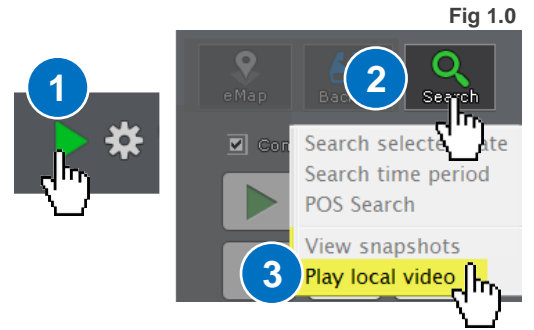


Reviewing Footage that was previously downloaded

This guide is intended to show Users how to review footage that was **previously downloaded** to the local hard disk drive.

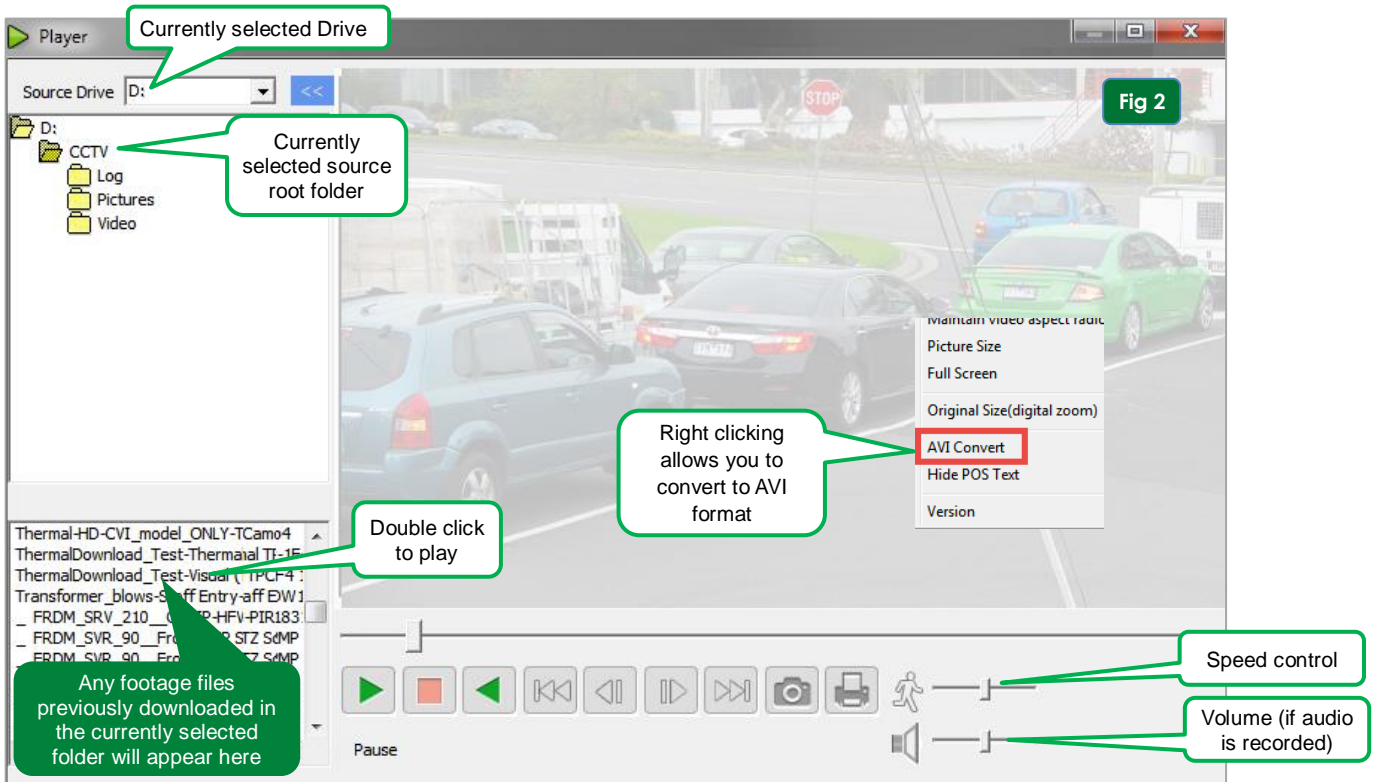
To review footage that has previously been downloaded to a local hard disk drive you use what's known as the **'Local Player'**. The 'Local Player' can be opened by navigating to Playback, clicking the **'Search'** button and selecting **'Play local video'** option as seen to the right Fig 1.



This opens the **'Local Player'** application as seen in Fig 2

Selecting the correct footage path location

By default when opening the Local Player application **from within** the Freedom software it will open in the folder as configured in the 'Save Capture Path' setting. If you wish to view pre-downloaded footage from an external storage device like a USB device or DVD you need to select the correct drive source and folder.
